While our primary interest encompasses the area bounded by Kirkham Street to the north, Ninth Avenue to the east, Santiago Street to the south and Nineteenth Avenue to the west, our concerns extend to adjoining areas as well. We strive to represent the interests of all of our neighbors, homeowners and tenants alike.

In addition to dealing with routine matters such as parking and traffic, development, and maintenance of parks and other public property, we can point to several accomplishments in 2018:

- GGHNA completed our commitments, in terms of matching funds and volunteer hours, for the Park Improvement Bond Funds! Thanks to all of our neighbors who have supported this effort over the past six years.
- GGHNA’s advocacy for replacement of the Golden Gate Heights Park playground has finally met with success. In a surprising move, the playground project will be coordinated with the other park improvements to minimize duplication of effort and the length of disruption.
- Join us in thanking our neighbor Seth Socolow for spearheading the effort to get the tennis courts at Golden Gate Heights Park resurfaced! This project had been postponed repeatedly over the years (or so we were told), but Seth finally made it happen!
- GGHNA has been working with StopCrimeSF and SFPD Taraval Station to address the seemingly endless string of car break-ins and other property crimes.
- GGHNA has been participating in and/or monitoring other projects, such as the Resilient Inner Sunset project and the proposed Green Benefit District.

The Golden Gate Heights Neighborhood Association holds funds for the maintenance of the Moraga/16th Tiled Steps project, maintenance of the multi-user water fountain at Golden Gate Heights Park, and providing compostable dog waste bags at Golden Gate Heights Park.
